The computer presenter is responsible for running the computer for lyrics, videos, and sermon slides for worship services and special events.

When

Worship Services: Saturday 6 PM, Sunday 8 AM, or Sunday 10:30 AM,

Special Events: As scheduled throughout the year.

Qualifications/Expectations

The computer presenter needs basic skills in navigating a computer. Currently we use an iMac computer, so Mac experience is a bonus. We expect these volunteers to be proactive in seeing needs (files, slides, etc.), creative in using backgrounds and colors, and knowledgeable with many worship songs from both the traditional and contemporary services. We expect you to preview sermon notes, familiarize yourself with songs sung the week you are scheduled, and stay focused for the duration for the service.

Training

Every computer presenter will be given a short online video training as well as a one-on-one coaching sessions with a computer tech. You will have at least one time of shadowing a computer tech through a service, until you feel comfortable with the startup, setup of files, changing of programs (if necessary), and shutting down the system properly.

Why?

The message on Sundays is both audible and visual. The assistance provided with the lyrics are a vital role in our worship times. The computer tech role provides videos for sermon illustrations, sermon notes, lyrics for songs, and pictures for announcements and other special moments in our services. All of these aspects help enhance the experience for those that attend as we strive to do our best and do everything with excellence "as unto the Lord."
