Sound Technician

Ministry Description

The sound technician is responsible for mixing the sound for the sanctuary and/or radio feed for worship services and special events.

When

Worship Services: *Saturday 6 PM, Sunday 8 AM, or *Sunday 10:30 AM,

*These services require sound techs at rehearsal Thursday evenings from 7 - 8:30 PM.

Special Events: As scheduled throughout the year.

Qualifications/Expectations

Sound technicians need to be humble, gracious, and yet articulate. A sound technician needs to be able to communicate with the musicians well, and work to understand the musicians' needs. Obviously, a sound technician needs to have a good sense and feel of worship music and have excellent hearing. Even if you have no experience with sound mixing, our training can equip you to become a sound tech.

Training

Every sound tech (regardless of prior experience) will be given extensive training which includes a 3-disc DVD series, a one-on-one coaching session with one of our current sound techs, and a 4-week live-service training which involves 1. watching, 2. speaking-and-watching, 3. speaking-and-doing, and 4. doing. Sound techs will begin mixing in the radio room. With consistent results, the sound techs will be further trained on sanctuary sound. With our technology, we are able to use recordings from our own rehearsals and services to practice mixing.

Why?

It is vital that the message being spoken is heard with clarity, and the environment for worship is welcoming and pleasant to those that come. We believe we should pursue excellence in all that we do, "as if doing it unto the Lord." Our musicians are only as good as the sound technicians, because the sound must pass through the sound console to be heard. Your role is of great importance to the flow and feel of every worship service.
